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# 1.0 Purpose

1.1. The purpose of this document is to adopt a standard helmet color code for firefighters depicting firefighter operational status.

### 2.0 Responsibilities

- 2.1. The Fire Chief shall assure that these standards are adhered to, establishing continuity throughout the county.
- 2.2. The Fire Chief shall identify each firefighter's classification using existing helmet designations until the time of new purchases. (See Section 6)

# 3.0 Helmet Construction

- 3.1. All helmets within the Taylors Bridge Fire Department must meet or exceed the minimum standards found in NFPA 1971 *Standard on Protective Ensemble for Structural Fire Fighting*, 2000 edition.
- 3.2. The brand and variety of helmet a department chooses is not governed by this guideline.
- 3.3. Helmets issued by this department must have the individual's firefighter status clearly marked. Helmets differ in the marking locations, (leather helmet fronts, side stickers, etc.) and are inexpensive to replace.

#### 4.0 Requirement

- 4.1. White Helmet Chief Officers
  - 4.1.1. Fire Chief
  - 4.1.2. Deputy Chief
  - 4.1.3. Assistant Chief
- 4.2. Red Helmet Captains
- 4.3. Red Helmet Lieutenants



## 4.4. Black – All Firefighters

- 4.4.1. Probationary Less than one year of service
- 4.4.2. Firefighter Firefighters that **DO NOT MEET** NFPA 1403 Standards.
- 4.4.3. Senior Firefighter Firefighters that MEET NFPA 1403 Standards

#### 4.5. Blue Helmet – Junior Firefighters

- 4.5.1. Auxiliary Firefighters
- 4.5.2. Less than 18 years of age
- 4.6. Orange Helmet Safety Officer

#### 5.0 Existing Helmet Conditions

- 5.1. Until the department replaces a helmet, it is acceptable to use the existing helmet colors in the department.
- 5.2. However, the firefighter status must **clearly** be marked these helmets.
- 5.3. Example #1:
  - 5.3.1. Safety Officer
  - 5.3.2. Existing Helmet Yellow
  - 5.3.3. Side Crescents or Helmet Front must signify "Safety Officer".
- 5.4. Example #2
  - 5.4.1. Probationary Firefighter
  - 5.4.2. Existing Helmet Black
  - 5.4.3. Side Crescents or Helmet Front must signify "Probationary", "Cadet" or some type of wording signifying that the firefighter is not yet full firefighter status.
- 5.5. Example #3
  - 5.5.1. Senior Firefighter
  - 5.5.2. Existing Helmet Black
  - 5.5.3. Side Crescents or Helmet Front must signify "Firefighter". Also, a two(2) inch dot shall be placed on the rear of the helmet to signify that the firefighter is trained to enter inside a burning structure.
